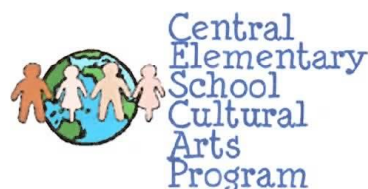

Chaperones: Please meet in front of Central School at 8:30 am. We will escort the 3rd graders to the Village Town Hall Auditorium when they make it to us. We will begin the tour in the Riverside Village Town Hall Auditorium. Charlie Pipal will introduce Riverside's rich cultural and architectural history to the students.

Station Volunteers: Please help us chaperone the students to the Village Hall Auditorium for the Riverside presentation. After the presentation, please proceed to your station.

Presentation about Riverside History and Architecture – Charlie Pipal - Riverside Town Hall Auditorium

After Mr. Pipal's presentation, we will remind the students to be on their best behavior and be respectful of our community.

We will then separate the students into five station groups. (parent chaperones will most likely want to be in the station group with their child). We will distribute clipboards with a Riverside Quiz, a WordSearch and Sketch paper and escort the students to their first station. We will all have a snack together in Guthrie Park around 11:15 AM and be back to school by 11:30 AM.
